RE: Proposed Truck Wash and Truck Servicing Facility at the Southeast Corner of the Intersection of Road 68 and Robinson Street, Visalia

Dear Mr. Fleming:

I am writing this letter on behalf of the referenced project, and in response to the Visalia Public Works Director's request that information on anticipated wastewater is provided to you, specifically maximum, peak and average daily flows, anticipated five-day Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD<sub>5</sub>) and Total Suspended Solids (TSS). To give the City and the District confidence in my statements herein, I am providing some of my background, experience and credentials in the field of wastewater, as follows:

I have been working in the wastewater field for over 50 years and am a certified Grade 5 Operator. I have managed numerous treatment plants, as well as construction of new plants, start-up, and troubleshooting. In 1997, I founded the company *Popichak Environmental*. *Popichak Environmental* globally provides consultation to numerous municipalities and private treatment plants, large and small, to improve and upgrade wastewater treatment, testing, troubleshooting, record keeping, documentation, and agency reporting. *Popichak Environmental* also manages several private wastewater treatment plants to include maintenance, testing, adherence to regulations and day to day operations. My company employs a civil engineer, operators of various levels, and maintenance personnel. We are occasionally involved in the quality control and assurance of new plant construction, as well as initial start-up and troubleshooting. *Popichak Environmental* also provides theoretical and hands-on training to operators. Most of our clients are based in southern California; however, our work has taken us to Guam, Alaska, and most other U.S. states.

It is my understanding that the referenced project is a proposed truck servicing facility consisting of 9,400 square feet of mechanic's shop and a truck wash, and 10,270 square feet dedicated to parts storage, break room, conference room, offices and sales area. The initial 8-hour work shift will require 10 employees, and a second 4-hour work shift will require 4 employees. The facility will include five unisex restrooms. Three restrooms will have one water closet, a urinal and sink. Two restrooms will have only one water closet and one sink. In addition, the facility will have a break room and a room with a mop sink. There are no cooking, laundry, or garbage disposal

systems proposed. Furthermore, the truck wash is self-contained and recycles, treats, and reuses wash water. Storm water runoff will be entirely contained on-site.

Of course, until construction of the facility, there will be no effluent to test for BOD5. But, having maintained and operated a number small wastewater treatment facilities, and providing testing for those, it is my experience a facility such as the proposed project will have a BOD5 and a TSS loading of less than 200 mg/l and 30 mg/l, respectively. Using 0.17 lbs of BOD5 per person, which is typical for residential wastewater, yields a BOD5 between 300 and 400mg/l, depending on water usage. However, wastewater from the proposed project is anticipated to contain far less organic matter than residential wastewater, thus the oxygen required for decomposition and total dissolved solids will be far less. Again, the project will have no cooking facilities, showers, laundry, or garbage disposal. Over the years, said anticipated BOD5 for the truck servicing facility is supported by numerous tests of influent into small treatment systems.

Flow calculations based on a fixture unit count have been attached indicating a theoretical flow of roughly 400 gallons per day. From my own experience the "Fixture Unit" method for flow calculations is somewhat arbitrary and is not representative of a facility such as the proposed. Typical flow measurements for a facility such as the proposed truck wash and servicing facility range between 10 and 20 gallons per day per employee per eight-hour shift. A flow calculation using the higher range of 20 gallons per employee per 8-hour shift yields 240 gallons per day. Thus the 400 gallons per day should be considered the maximum day, and 240 gallon as the average daily flow. The monthly average flow is anticipated to be less than 0.0058 MGD.

Dear Mr. Fleming:

The City of Visalia has reviewed the request of Goshen Community Services District to increase the GCSD's annual Average Daily Discharge that is permitted under the June 6, 1995 Water Service Agreement between the City and the GCSD. The City has determined that it has available capacity to accommodate the requested increase, and the City Council therefore accepted the requested increase at its regular meeting held on December 18, 2023.

Section 4.4 of the Water Service Agreement requires the City to determine the Additional Treatment Connection Charge applicable to the requested amount of increased capacity. The City has determined the Additional Treatment Connection Charge applicable to the current increase to be \$839,401. The charges were calculated in accordance with the City's fee schedule as follows:

203,000 gallons per day x \$2.69 = \$546,070

570 pounds per day x \$332.70 = \$186,639

Upon payment of the Additional Treatment Connection Charge, Section 2.1(a) and 2.1(b) of the Water Service Agreement shall be deemed amended as follows:
